Trip to Shakespeare's Globe Theatre, London
Friday 24 February 2012

It has been a while now since we have run the drama club and we are pleased with its success and that your child has continued to come along. We hope your child enjoys it as much as we enjoy running it and it has been wonderful to see different talents shine through with regard to acting, singing and dancing which are skills many people now need when pursuing both amateur and professional careers in drama.

We are keen to introduce children to, the world's most famous playwright, William Shakespeare, and have arranged a trip to Shakespeare's Globe Theatre which specialises in providing a theatre experience that is as close as possible to how it might have been when Shakespeare was writing and performing in 16th Century London. The trip will include a 90 minute workshop on Romeo and Juliet (where, it is hoped, children will be able to experience using the Globe stage if it is available) and a tour of the museum attached to the Globe.

The subsidised total cost of the trip would be £10.00 per child and we plan to travel by British Rail, departing and returning to Falconwood via London Bridge. We will be leaving from the school premises at around 9.15am and hope to return just after 3pm, so your child would need to be dropped off and picked up from school as normal and should wear a school uniform. If your child needs medication (e.g. an asthma pump), please ensure they bring this to either Miss Smalley or Mrs West at 9am on the day because medication will usually be kept with your child's class teacher. Please provide your child with a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks) and ensure they have a waterproof coat and sensible walking shoes.

We very much hope that your child will be able to join us for this very exciting opportunity to visit and learn drama skills at such a world famous venue.
